



Election Approval Process

Candidate - Nomination Process

Interested Members must submit required nomination documentation during the specified dates and times only and **must be in attendance** during the AGM on February 6, 2022 (meeting to begin at 1:00 p.m.).

To become an official candidate for election, you must be nominated by a current Member (who is active and in good standing with the Cosmetology Association). Nomination forms must include a resume, recent photograph, short bio, and maximum 2-minute video for viewing by Members (to include why you would like to be a Board Director and why you would make a good Director), and documentation must be forwarded to the Executive Director of the Cosmetology Association (executivedir@nscosmetology.ca) anytime between December 1st, 2021, and no later than 4:00 p.m. January 7, 2022. Candidate information, resume, picture, bio, and video will be posted to the Association's website for Members to view prior to the election.

The Board must approve all candidates. Once approved, the Executive Director will then notify each candidate of approval to run in the 2022 election.

Prior to approving a nominee to run in an election, the Board will consider the diverse needs of the Cosmetology Association, demographics, and the nominee's historical standing with the Association.

Online viewing by Members prior to a vote:

All information (video, recent photo, and short bio) sent to the Executive Director by candidates will be posted online on the Association's website (and/or other platforms) for Members to view prior to casting their vote for new Directors.
